Update on ICs Program

- 3 year term to support EPA's enforcement efforts
 - EPA and Orange County (start April 08)
 - 12 retail markets + wholesalers – once/month
 - EPA and LA County (start July 08)
 - 29 retail markets – once/6months
 - EPA and City of Long Beach (start July 08)
 - 15 retail markets – 3 times/year
- Scope of work
 - Market inspection/surveillance program
 - Advisory signage update
 - Support of overall PV Shelf program

2008 Inspector Training

- Inspector training - 20 OC food program managers & inspectors, 5 representatives from LA county and City of Long Beach
- New tools focusing on fish identification and regulations
- Developing county specific protocol
- Developing In-language materials specifically for inspectors

Review of Program Structure

- Continue FCEC program – education a key IC tool in risk reduction
- Continue to work on a fully integrated ICs/ Cleanup program to manage risk exposure
- Focus on the measuring incremental risk reduction
